Thank you for your letter to Attorney General Edmund G. Brown Jr. regarding your dispute with the California Department of Fair Employment and Housing (DFEH).

The Attorney General's Office is unable to assist or comment on this matter because we are required by law to provide legal representation to state agencies in disputes arising out of their actions. This duty precludes the Attorney General from representing individual citizens in their disagreements with state agencies or providing advice to any individual regarding the disputed activity.

While the Attorney General represents state departments in legal matters, he does not seek to impose his own policy judgments or control the administration of the business of his client agencies.

If you wish to pursue this matter, we suggest that you contact the director of the DFEH, your representatives in the California Legislature, and/or a private attorney.
